

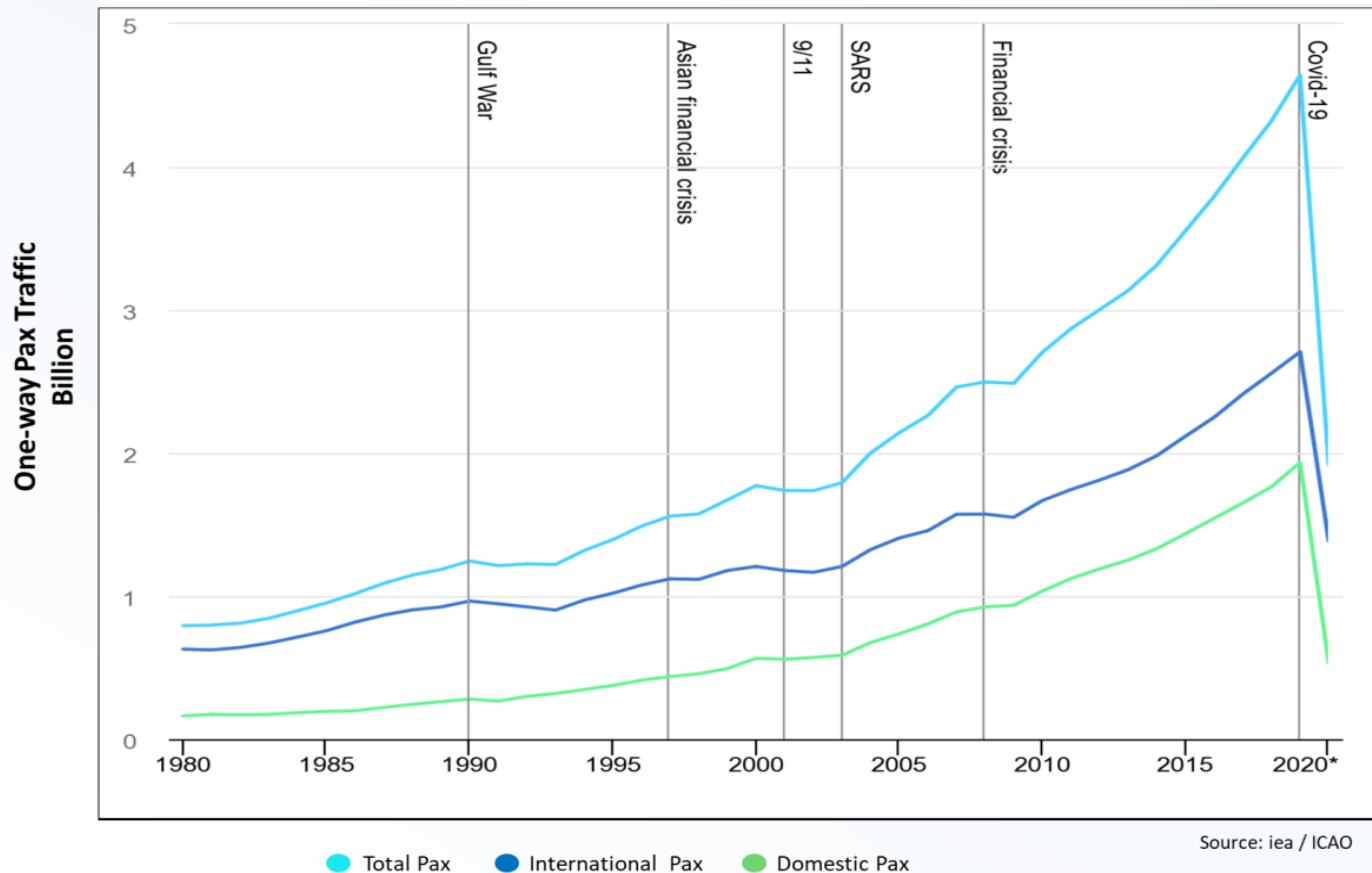

- In 2020, Africa has witnessed a 67% drop in passenger traffic compared to 2019.
